

## REVENUE SHARING FAQs FOR FY14 PROGRAM

- 1. When are the Revenue Sharing Program revisions effective?** The legislation (HB 1248) is effective July 1<sup>st</sup> and we anticipate providing the CTB a draft revised Revenue Sharing Policy and the Revenue Sharing Guidelines at the July CTB meeting for approval. The changes will be effective with the FY2013 applications.
- 2. When are applications going to be due?** We anticipate sending out requests for applications in August with a requested due date of November 1<sup>st</sup>. The selected projects will be approved at the June 2013 CTB meeting with the FY2014 funds available for expenditure July 1, 2013. (This will be our normal timeline for all future applications as well)
- 3. Who will decide if a project meets the priority criteria established in the legislation?** The locality will indicate on the application if a project meets the priority criteria and VDOT will review. For maintenance projects, VDOT will provide the condition data to verify that determination for all VDOT maintained facilities.
- 4. What supporting information/documents may be needed if trying to establish a maintenance project meets the priority criteria?** We are currently working with the Maintenance and Bridge Divisions for guidance on this. Our Revenue Sharing Guidelines (anticipated to be revised in July) will provide this information.
- 5. Is all maintenance work eligible for Revenue Sharing funding or only those activities that are below VDOT's maintenance targets?** Any maintenance project is eligible however priority will be given to those maintenance projects (bridges and pavement) that are below the established condition ratings. More details will be provided in the revised Revenue Sharing Guidelines.
- 6. Does the new legislation mean I can apply for \$15M (\$10M for construction and \$5M for Maintenance?)** NO – the legislation allows a locality to request a maximum of \$10M and provides that up to \$5M of that request can be specified for maintenance projects.
- 7. Is there a new priority order for Revenue Sharing requests?** The priority order will be modified to reflect the allowance for maintenance. The priority order that requests will be reviewed in will be established in the revised Revenue Sharing Guidelines.
- 8. Will the application be the same this year?** NO – the application will be revised to allow localities to specify whether they are requesting funds for a maintenance or construction project and to allow a locality to indicate whether the project meets the priority criteria. The application will be updated prior to the new Guidelines being approved. *Any application submitted on the old form will not be accepted.*
- 9. If I am applying for a maintenance project can I use my quarterly maintenance payments as my match?** NO – the Urban Manual specifically indicates use of these payments as the matching allocation to VDOT funds is not allowed. Additionally only non-VDOT funds can be used as the match for revenue sharing funds.
