

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 20-2

Waiving through June 10, 2020, any penalties and interest on late payments of the tax on purchased meals.

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to assist its residents and businesses as the City contends with the state of emergency and disaster that the COVID-19 pandemic has caused; and

WHEREAS, Virginia Code § 15.2-1413 authorizes the Council to act to assure continuity in government during a disaster; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that providing taxpayers relief from penalties and interest associated with late remittances of the tax on purchased meals will promote continuity of government and grant tax relief to businesses and individuals the disaster affects; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLONIAL HEIGHTS:

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Colonial Heights City Code § 258-42.7, penalties and interest shall not accrue for any late remittance of the tax on purchased meals that would first be due and payable to the City from March 20, 2020, through June 10, 2020, if remitted on or before June 10, 2020.
2. The relief that paragraph 1 above affords shall not delay the due date of reports that City Code § 258-42.6 requires or affect remittances that are due before March 20, 2020.
3. This emergency ordinance shall be in effect upon approval after one reading and shall remain in effect through June 10, 2020.
