ITEM: Ordinance No. 20-11

PROPOSED ACTION: Approve Ordinance No. 20-11 on first reading.

BACKGROUND: Due to the Director of Emergency Services' disaster declaration caused by the COVID-19 outbreak, the City Manager requests that the 8% penalty, the \$10 charge, and \$50 administrative fee for unpaid utility bills be discontinued during the declared disaster, and for up to 30 days after the end of the declared disaster. The City Manager also requests that because of the current disaster, water service not be disconnected due to non-payment of charges during the declared disaster, and for up to 60 days after the end of the City's declared disaster. Ordinance No. 20-11 authorizes – but does not mandate – the City Manager to provide such relief during, and for a finite time after, the period of a local disaster.
