SUBJECT: Special Use Permit Findings

This memorandum is in regards to the Special Use Permit request made by Chuck Barnes of 155 Chesterfield Avenue. There have been complaints on this residence regarding the number of animals on the property as well as barking. I have responded to this residence twice in the last few months. I have also spoken with Mr. Barnes and other family members in regards to the matter.

On December 8, 2020 I responded to 155 Chesterfield Avenue to conduct my investigation. Upon arriving on scene, all five canines were outside in the fenced yard and barking in response to my arrival. The residents of 163 Chesterfield Avenue were not at home. A notice was left on the residence with a request to call Animal Control in response to the Special Use Permit. I did speak with the homeowner of 153 Chesterfield Avenue whom did indicate he was aware of the number of animals on the property, acknowledged their barking but concluded that he did not believe having one more dog would make any additional difference. The homeowner of 105 Battery Place indicated he was aware of the number of animals on their property but that they didn't bother him directly. There were no additional findings in reference to this matter. On December 11, 2020 I conducted a follow up at 163 Chesterfield Avenue in reference to this matter and left a secondary notice. I received a voicemail in the early afternoon from the homeowner advising that in reference to 155 Chesterfield Avenue, it is their yard, their business and they can have what they want and it is no business of hers.

At this time, I would agree to the Special Use Permit. The following stipulations would be that Mr. Barnes finishes the screen on his fence line that had been previously discussed. Additionally, the remaining canine is to be spayed/neutered and registered with the City immediately. All others are fixed and up to date. No additional canines should be kept or housed at this residence at any time. There is nothing else further.
