## Suspect Sought for Armed Robbery

On November 7, 2016 at approximately 12:23 pm, Colonial Heights Police responded to a report of an armed robbery at the Union First Market Bank located at 3107 Boulevard Suite 15. An employee reported the suspect walked up to the counter and passed a note demanding money and advising he had a gun. The suspect then fled on foot with undisclosed amount of cash.

The suspect is described as a white male, with a thin mustache, beard and goatee, 6'1" to 6'2", slim build and in his twenties. He was last seen wearing a black and red ball cap, a dark hoodie (navy or black), black rimmed glasses, and a watch with a brown band.

This is a joint investigation conducted by the Colonial Heights Police Department and the FBI Bank Robbery Task Force. This suspect is possibly responsible for 3 additional bank robberies occurring in the Richmond/Metro Area. The FBI has named this suspect the "Soul Patch Bandit".
