Bank Robbery Suspect Sought

On December 1, 2016, at approximately 11:15 a.m., an unidentified suspect entered First Citizens Bank located at 2000 Snead Avenue and presented the teller with a note demanding money. The suspect did not display a weapon. After obtaining cash the suspect fled and was last seen getting into a green minivan that was parked in the parking lot. The suspect vehicle was driven by a black female and was last seen headed east on Temple Ave.

The suspect is described as a black male, wearing a black knit hat, black coat, and tan pants. He is believed to be in his late 20s to early 30s and is approximately 5'5" to 5'7" tall and 150-160 lbs.
