## Colonial Heights Police Make Arrest for Embezzlement

On April 15, 2019, Colonial Heights Police received information regarding a possible theft involving the Conjurers Neck Homeowners Association. Colonial Heights Detectives investigated and determined that there were in fact fraudulent transactions, in excess of \$55,000, that occurred between October 2017 and April 2019.

Roberta “Bobbie” D. Fauber has subsequently been charged with six (6) counts of Embezzlement. Fauber had, up until recently, held the position of Treasurer of the Conjurers Neck Homeowners Association. On July 23, 2019, Fauber surrendered herself to Colonial Heights Police and was processed and released on a \$5000 unsecured bond, pending her next court appearance on July 30, 2019, at 9:00am in the Colonial Heights Circuit Court.
