## Colonial Heights Police Make Arrest for Embezzlement

On April 15, 2019, Colonial Heights Police received information regarding a possible theft involving the Conjurers Neck Homeowners Association. Colonial Heights Detectives investigated and determined that there were in fact fraudulent transactions, in excess of \$55,000, that occurred between October 2017 and April 2019.

Roberta “Bobbie” D. Fauber has subsequently been charged with six (6) counts of Embezzlement. Fauber [REDACTED] held the position of Treasurer of the Conjurers Neck Homeowners Association. [REDACTED] Fauber surrendered herself to Colonial Heights Police [REDACTED] and was processed and released on a [REDACTED] unsecured bond [REDACTED] pending her next court appearance on [REDACTED] 2019 [REDACTED] at [REDACTED] in the Colonial Heights Circuit Court.
