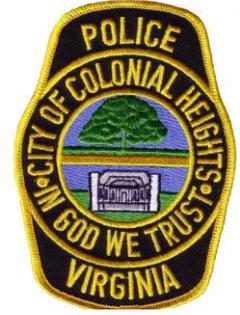

Colonial Heights Police Make Bank Robbery Arrest

On February 7, 2020, the Colonial Heights Police Department arrested Robert Bruce Hall Jr. of Chesterfield, for the robbery of the Atlantic Union Bank located in the 3000 Block of the Boulevard in Colonial Heights.

On February 7, 2020 at approximately 9:45am, Hall entered the Atlantic Union Bank and presented the teller with a note demanding cash. Then after receiving an unspecified amount of currency, left the bank in an unknown direction. A short time later, Hall voluntarily came to the lobby of police headquarters and surrendered. During the crime, no weapon was presented and there were no reported injuries. Hall has been charged with Robbery and Grand Larceny and is currently being held at Riverside Regional Jail with no bond, pending his next court appearance in Colonial Heights General District Court on February 10, 2020 at 11:30am.
