## **CURFEW DECLARED IN COLONIAL HEIGHTS**

The City of Colonial Heights is declaring a curfew from 11:00 pm – 6:00 am. No one should be on the roads except emergency personnel. This curfew will be in effect beginning tonight, August 28, 2011 until further notice.

This curfew applies to all persons within the City except federal, state, and local law enforcement; fire, rescue, and utility company personnel; emergency operating personnel; and contractors performing services directed by the City Manager, Thomas L. Mattis, Director of Emergency Services Management. This curfew is declared under the local declared emergency for Hurricane Irene.

There are many businesses and intersections with no power, downed trees, branches and power lines, as well as blocked streets. “The purpose of a curfew is to keep the public as safe as possible and to allow all of our emergency personnel to do their jobs in a safe and efficient manner,” said Police Chief Jeffrey W. Faries.
