Three Arrested for Passing Counterfeit Currency

On November 1, 2011 at approximately 9:22 p.m. Colonial Heights Police responded to the Target Store located at 721 Southpark Boulevard in reference to subjects passing counterfeit \$100 bills. Upon arrival officers were informed by store security that a male and female had been in the store and made purchases with nine counterfeit \$100 bills. Chesterfield County Police responded to the scene during the initial investigation due to a similar incident that occurred at the Target Store located on Jefferson Davis Highway in Chesterfield County. The suspects were located, along with a third suspect, a short time later at the Wal-Mart Store on Southpark Blvd where they had also made purchases using five counterfeit \$100 bills. All three suspects were taken into custody by Colonial Heights Police. A search of the suspects and their vehicle led to the discovery of additional counterfeit currency as well as merchandise from other stores in the area. The United States Secret Service was notified and responded to assist with the investigation which is ongoing. The following suspects were taken into custody:


