HAZARDOUS MATERIAL SPILL

At about 7:55 this morning, the fire department received a phone call from school personnel about a portable tank overturned on Conduit Road. The report stated that it was leaking an unknown liquid. The incident was between West Roslyn Road and East Westover Avenue. When fire units arrived, they found the tank with a minor leak. The tank had a product label for a strong insecticide. The Crater Regional Hazardous Material team was called to the scene to control the spill. After the spill was contained, a clean up company was contracted by the City to remove the hazard. Conduit Road was closed while the hazardous material team took samples and up righted the container. No one was injured and no one was evacuated.
