APARTMENT FIRE

Colonial Heights Fire and EMS responded at 12:17 AM today to 64 Colonial Court for an apartment fire. When units arrived, they had fire showing from a second floor bedroom window. Fire crews made entry and searched for occupants, but no one was home. The neighbors next door were alerted by police and safely evacuated. No one was injured. Chesterfield Engine 12, Engine 8, Truck 12, Truck 14, and Battalion 2 responded to assist. The fire was contained to the second floor and attic. The incident was under control in about 30 minutes. The two occupants in the neighboring apartment and the one occupant in another apartment in the same building have been displaced. The cause of the fire remains under investigation. Estimated damage is about \$50,000 dollars.
