TERMINATION OF MANDATORY WATER USE RESTRICTIONS EFFECTIVE FRIDAY, JANUARY 4, 2013

Residents and businesses in the City of Colonial Heights are hereby notified that mandatory water use restrictions that have been in effect since August, 2012 are **terminated** effective Friday, January 4, 2013.

Although Voluntary Water Conservation measures remain in effect, all outdoor water uses are now permitted at any time on any day until further notice.

This action is in response to the recommendation of the city's water provider, the Appomattox River Water Authority (ARWA) – and the fact that the Lake Chesdin Reservoir returned to full pool on December 27th.

Colonial Heights water users should still continue to conserve water, however, as drought conditions are expected to continue within the Appomattox River Watershed Basin for the next three months (according to the most recent National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration Report).
