Two Suspects in Custody after Armed Robbery and Shooting

Colonial Heights Police have arrested two suspects for a robbery and malicious wounding that occurred in the 100 blk. of Biltmore Dr. on June 2nd at 6:50 p.m. The vehicle that the suspects were driving was stopped for a speeding violation shortly before the shooting call was dispatched. The two subjects in the vehicle were quickly linked as involved in the area shooting. Derek Alphonso Jackson Jr. was charged with 2 counts of robbery, conspiracy, and the use of a firearm in the commission of a felony. Nicholas Colburne-Garrett was charged with 2 counts of robbery, malicious wounding, conspiracy and use of a firearm in the commission of a felony. One victim, who was shot, was transported and after undergoing surgery is now recovering. Both suspects are incarcerated at the Riverside Regional Jail with no bond. Both suspects have also been linked to another robbery which took place on May 1st in the 400 block of Norwood Drive where a 93 year old woman was robbed. Charges in this case are forthcoming.
