### HOUSE FIRE

Today 02/13/16 at 09:35, Colonial Heights Fire and EMS along with Chesterfield were dispatched to the 100 Block of Lexington Dr. for a reported house fire. When fire units arrived they had heavy fire conditions. The fire quickly spread throughout the interior. The house suffered major damage prior to being under control. The fire was marked under control at 10:48. The occupants were home at the time and were able to escape without injury. Colonial Heights units were Engine 1, Quint 2, Squad 2, Medic, Battalion Chief, and the Deputy Fire Marshal. Chesterfield units on scene were Engine 21, Truck 12, Battalion Chief, and Safety Officer. Fort Lee engine also responded to the scene for additional manpower. Red Cross was called to the scene to assist the residence. The cause was determined to be accidental when paper towels came in contact with the stove during cooking.
