November 3, 2020 General Election




1. Election Day. Polling Places open from 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
2. Early Voting In-Person. Available at Registrar's office, City Hall, 1st floor beginning Friday, September 18 and ending Saturday, October 31.
3. Absentee Vote by Mail. Submit an application now to receive a ballot in mid-September.

## EARLY VOTING IN-PERSON

November 3, 2020 General Election



You can vote early at your local Registrar's office beginning Friday, September 18 and ending Saturday, October 31. You do not have to have a reason or fill out an application to vote early. At the Registrar's office, you must provide your name and address and show an acceptable form of ID or sign an ID Confirmation Statement. Curbside voting is available upon request.


