CASE MANAGEMENT SERVICES

Case Management Services provides seniors the opportunity to be active decision makers regarding long-term care. The goal is to enable the seniors to maintain optimal living and independence in the community for as long as safely possible. Case Managers provide outreach, information and assistance by thoroughly assessing the individual's unique living situation.



A case manager will be assigned to each participant of CDAAA regardless of which service they receive. This allows the participant to have a continuity of care when receiving services. Your individual Case Manager will be the gatekeeper for all services that you may need while receiving services with CDAAA. SUPPORT SERVICES

Adult Day Care Services

CDAAA is able to provide scholarships for care in a community based program. This program will provide comprehensive care and a variety of health, social and other related services in a protective setting. This program is licensed by the Commonwealth of Virginia.



Homemaker Services

This program provides assistance in the home with light housekeeping tasks that the recipients are unable to perform. These task may include house cleaning, assistance in preparing meals, and other task around the home.
