A. AN ORDINANCE NO 21-FIN-10

(*Second Reading*) To amend the General Fund Budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2022, by appropriating \$137,801 consisting of 1) \$29,724 in grant funds from the Department of Criminal Justice Services for the Police Department's Body-Worn Camera Program; 2) \$51,470 in grant funds from the Rescue Squad Assistance Fund for mobile data computers for the Fire & EMS Department; 3) \$8,600 in grant funds from the VA Department of Conservation and Recreation for the summer Youth Conservation Corps Program at Pocahontas State Park; 4) \$21,607 carried forward from FY2021 for an Economic Development website, and 5) \$26,400 in state reimbursement for a legislated increase in the Registrar's salary.

To amend the Capital Projects Budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2022, by appropriating \$156,200 in FEMA grant funds for the replacement of a generator at Colonial Heights Middle School and transferring \$63,800 from the Fire Station #2 insulation project to the Colonial Heights Middle School generator project for the required local match.
