

A RESOLUTION NO. 19-50

Authorizing the City Manager to accept a Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response (SAFER) grant from the Department of Homeland Security Federal Emergency Management Agency for six additional firefighters.

WHEREAS, the City applied for and has been awarded a three-year grant from the Department of Homeland Security Federal Emergency Management Agency for six additional firefighters; and

WHEREAS, the grant awarded over the three-year period is approximately \$799,022 in federal funds (\$323,928 in year one; \$323,928 in year two; and \$151,166 in year three) and local share funding of approximately \$496,690 (\$107,976 in year one; \$107,976 in year two; and \$280,738 in year three). The City will be responsible for paying the total costs of the additional firefighters beginning in year four; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLONIAL HEIGHTS:

1. That Douglas E. Smith, City Manager, is hereby authorized, on behalf of the City, to accept a three-year grant from the Department of Homeland Security Federal Emergency Management Agency for six new firefighters in the amount of \$799,022 in federal funds, with local share funding of \$496,690.

2. That this resolution shall be in full force and effect upon approval.
