**BACKGROUND:** A Regional Public Safety Training Facility is proposed to be constructed near Temple Avenue, located on Fort Lee. This facility will include a burn building and provide for more frequent and efficient access for training; and allow localities to train together, which will greatly improve multi-jurisdictional readiness in times of large-scale emergencies requiring mutual aid (additional information about the proposed facility is attached).

Congressman McEachin's Office provided notification of the opportunity to submit requests for federal Community Project Funding for FY 22. Resolution No. 21-13 provides for support of the submission by the City of Hopewell of a Regional Public Safety Training Facility application for federal community project funding in the amount of \$2,000,000.
