PROPOSED ACTION: Approval of Resolution No. 22-18 to approve the Project Service Agreement for Municipal Solid Waste Collection and Disposal Services with Central Virginia Waste Management (CVWMA).

BACKGROUND: The current service agreement for Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) Collection and Disposal Services between the City and CVWMA expires on June 30, 2022. In anticipation of the agreement end date, CVWMA conducted a procurement process to select vendors for a new MSW Contract with Colonial Heights, Hopewell, Ashland and Petersburg as the municipalities being served. The selection committee, which included City staff, chose to move forward with Waste Management as the vendor on the next contract. CVWMA executed the MSW Collection and Disposal Services contract with Waste Management in March 2022 and recently submitted the Service Agreement for City review.

Resolution No. 22-18 provides for approval of the Project Service Agreement with CVWMA. The project service agreement provides that CVWMA, with Waste Management as its contractor, shall provide MSW collection and disposal services beginning on or about July 1, 2022 and ending on June 30, 2029.

Related to alley collection, the Project Service Agreement with CVWMA includes the following:

Manner of Collection and Disposal - MSW Collection Services shall provide for the weekly collection of MSW, as defined in Article II, placed in Containers set out by the ERU curbside or in the alley as specified by routes approved by the CVWMA. All MSW and Bulky Waste placed on the curb or alley adjacent to a specified ERU shall be collected and delivered to the identified, properly permitted and compliant Disposal Site.

An ERU in the agreement is an Equivalent Residential Unit which is defined as: A Residential Unit, a hotel, lodging house, restaurant, church, store, market, manufacturing plant, commercial establishment or other entity which receives residential type MSW collection and which is defined by the Participating Locality as equivalent to a Residential Unit for the purpose of MSW collection pursuant to this Contract.

In addition, CVWMA's agreement with Waste Management provides for the following related to alley collection:

Manner of Collection - Contractor shall perform MSW collection to ensure that it creates a minimum of disruption to the neighborhoods where it provides these services. All MSW and Routine Bulky Waste placed on the curb or alley adjacent to a specified ERU shall be collected...
