

AN ORDINANCE NO. 22-FIN-8

To amend the General Fund Budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021 and ending June 30, 2022, by appropriating \$168,348 consisting of 1) \$1,000 in Restricted Fund Balance to the Police Department for Adopt a Cop; 2) \$4,025 in LOLE Grant Funds from DCJS to the Police Department; 3) \$2,000 in Restricted Fund Balance for E-Citation Funds to the Police Department; 4) \$37,849 in Assigned Fund Balance to Public Works for the Lakeview Dam Project; 5) \$80,443 in Contingency Funds to Public Works for sewer repair; and 6) a transfer of \$90,450 in Contingency Funds to Public Works for purchase of garbage containers.

To amend the Emergency Response Budget by appropriating \$30,055 in ARPA Funds for the Colonial Heights Sanitary Sewer Assessments.

To amend the Water and Sewer Fund Budget by appropriating \$80,443 from Contingency Funds for emergency sewer repair.

THE CITY OF COLONIAL HEIGHTS HEREBY ORDAINS:

1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 22-FIN-7, the General Fund Budget, is hereby amended and re-ordained as follows:

a. The budget designated the General Fund Budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2022, is hereby adopted; and that subject to transfers by resolution pursuant to § 6.15 of the City Charter, funds hereby appropriated shall be used for the following purposes:
