Park Authority Mobile Food Vending

Fairfax County Park Authority is offering a new and exciting service for park visitors. Mobile food vendors now have an opportunity to provide food services to customers in selected parks. Authorized mobile food vendors will contribute to the park environment by offering specialty food items, premium customer service, and affordable menu selections.

A mobile food vendor is defined as a "licensed, motorized mobile food unit which is temporarily located on a Fairfax County Park Authority designated vending pad where food items are sold to the general public." Mobile food vendors are permitted on approved Fairfax County Park Authority property provided certain standards are met and appropriate permits are obtained.

Who is Eligible?

Fairfax County Park Authority is interested in vendors that can provide quality representation of the county's cultural diversity with unique and specialty food items. Interested vendors must have a self-contained truck with the ability to provide mobile food vending services. Mobile food carts can be considered for some locations. Any other vending alternatives are not permitted. Vendors must provide all required documentation listed in the 'How to Apply' section prior to obtaining a permit from Fairfax County Park Authority.

When is Vending Permitted?

Permit Holders may set their own flexible working schedule for each individual park, but may not be in the park before park opening (dawn), or after closure. Fairfax County Park Authority expects vendors to provide consistent and frequent service. It is not required for a permit holder to be at the park every day or to stay for any designated amount of time. Mobile vending trucks and all associated equipment must be removed from the park at the end of each day. Equipment is not permitted in the park overnight at any time.

How to Apply/Selection Process

Vendors will be selected based on: complete application package, visual appearance of the food truck, proposed operating plan, variety of menu items that appeal to park customers, and other criteria. A higher priority will be assigned to applications that propose frequent and consistent services and hours of operation.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

Optional/Additional Regulations

Under the Zoning Ordinance City of Charlottesville

Sec. 34-1175. - **Mobile food unit**.

A **mobile food unit** located on private property authorized by following regulations:

- (1) No **mobile food unit** may be operated on private property having first been issued a provisional use permit.
- (2) A provisional use permit allows the permittee to operate applicant may apply for more than one (1) provisional use.
- (3) Applicants for a provisional use permit authorizing a **mobile food unit** must provide:
 - a. A city business license (or a statement from the com is required).
 - b. A valid health permit from the Virginia Health Department applicable standards. A valid health permit must be issued.
 - c. Written permission from the owner(s) of the private property.
 - d. A sketch to be approved by the zoning administrator showing all parking areas, routes for ingress and egress, placement of property lines, garbage receptacles and any other features.
- (4) A **mobile food unit** provisional use permit is valid for one year.
- (5) A **mobile food unit** operator shall not:

(c) Operating a **food truck** outside of authorized areas, without the possibility private property owners shall be considered a violation of this article vendor's business license.

Sec. 32-278. - Hours of operation.

No vendor shall operate except between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. in parking locations, or approved vending locations during non-operating hours designee for special events.

([Ord. No. 2016-08, § 2](#)(Exh. A), 1-26-2016)

Sec. 32-279. - Signs restricted.

- (a) All signs must be firmly attached at all points to the **food** or ice cream portion of the rear of the sign is visible.
- (b) Flags, banners, portable signs such as A-frames, or other decorative signs.

([Ord. No. 2016-08, § 2](#)(Exh. A), 1-26-2016)

Sec. 32-280. - Noise restricted.

- (a) Food and ice cream trucks, including those operating with a general permit, the same may be amended, moved, or superseded from time to time forth in [section 24-255\(d\)](#) (as the same may be amended, moved or superseded).
- (1) *Residential zones; night.* In a residential zone between 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. on any public street, sidewalk or parking lot or any privately owned street, sidewalk or parking lot open to the public, except to summon aid in an emergency.
- (2) *Residential zones; day.* In a residential zone between 6:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. on any public street, sidewalk or parking lot or any privately owned street, sidewalk or parking lot open to the public, except to summon aid in an emergency.

Henrico County, VA Code of Ordinances

Sec. 10-68. - Prohibited noises enumerated.

It shall be unlawful for any person to cause or permit to be caused any of the following prohibited sounds or noises:

- (1) *Social gatherings and parties.* Allowing any noise between 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. generated from a gathering of ten or more people that is plainly audible:
 - a. Inside the confines of the dwelling unit, house or apartment of another person; or
 - b. In a residential area, at 100 or more feet from the gathering.
- (2) *Sound-producing and sound-reproducing devices.* Except for commercial establishments located in areas zoned for urban mixed use, the use, operation or playing of any radio, phonograph,

Henrico County, VA Code of Ordinances

Peddlers and hawkers. Yelling, shouting, whistling, screaming or crying for the purpose of attracting attention to a performance, show, sale or display of merchandise between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. on any public street, sidewalk or parking lot or any privately owned street, sidewalk or parking lot open to the public, except to summon aid in an emergency.

- (7) *Amplified sound from vehicles.* Playing, using or operating, or permitting the playing, use or operation of, any radio, stereo, tape player, compact disc player, loudspeaker or other electronic device or mechanical equipment used for the amplification of sound, which is located on or within a motor vehicle and which is plainly audible from outside the motor vehicle at a distance of 50 feet or more. The provisions of this subsection shall not apply to the playing of music or jingles by an ice cream truck or similar mobile food service vehicle, provided such vehicle may emit sounds otherwise prohibited by this subsection only between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m.


