INTRODUCTION AND CONSIDERATION OF ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS

AN ORDINANCE NO 19-FIN-3 (UNANIMOUS PASS)
(First Reading) To amend the General Fund Budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018, and ending June 30, 2019, to appropriate \$304,149 in funds from the Riverside Regional Jail authority (RRJA) back to the RRJA in Compliance with bond requirements.

To amend the Water and Sewer Fund Budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018, and ending June 30, 2019, by appropriating \$398,150 in reimbursement funds from the South Central Wastewater Authority (SCWA) for emergency repairs of various sewer lines in the City and for completion of an infrastructure condition assessment and utility rate study.

Authorizing the City Manager to enter into the "Commonwealth of Virginia Voluntary Group Long-Term Care Insurance Program Employer Adoption Agreement" with the Virginia Retirement Center.
