## Death Investigation

On April 4<sup>th</sup>, 2024 at approximately 10:00 a.m., Colonial Heights Police along with Colonial Heights Fire & EMS responded to a residence in the 900 Block of Jamestown Drive for a report of an injured person. Upon arrival, they discovered a male victim who was deceased.

The investigation revealed that the victim, who was working for a local tree cutting company, was approximately fifty feet off the ground, trimming a tree limb from a bucket truck. While in the process of cutting the limb, a rope attached to the tree broke free, throwing the victim from the elevated bucket.

Colonial Heights Detectives conducted a preliminary investigation and there is no evidence of foul play. OSHA investigators has been notified of the incident.

The victim has been identified as Charles Sloan Jr, 47 years old, a resident of South Chesterfield, VA.
