
Arrest Made In Breaking And Entering

On 06/26/2024, at 6:05am, Colonial Heights Police responded to the 100 block of Lakeview Park Road in reference to an assault where a firearm was displayed.

Upon arrival, officers contacted the victim who advised that Jamyles Johnson, 23 years of age, and a resident of Petersburg, had forced entry into the apartment through a window. A verbal altercation between Johnson and the victim turned physical and Johnson displayed a firearm and threatened the victim. Once Johnson was informed that police had been called to the scene, he fled the area. The victim suffered non-life-threatening injuries.

On 06/26/2024, Colonial Heights Police, with the assistance of Chesterfield County Police, and the Petersburg Bureau of Police took Johnson into custody without incident. Johnson has been charged with Burglary with Intent to Commit a Felony, Aggravated Domestic Assault, Strangulation, Use of a Firearm in the Commission of a Felony, Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon, and Destruction of Property.

Johnson was incarcerated at Riverside Regional Jail with no bond.
