Aggravated Malicious Wounding

On September 8, 2024, at approximately 8:30 pm, units responded to a person shot in the area of Tussing Lane and Moorman Avenue. Once officers arrived, a 19-year-old victim was found suffering from an apparent gunshot wound to the head. The victim who was conscious and speaking with officers, was transported to VCU Medical Center for treatment.

The offender was identified as Donovan Neal, 21 years of age and a resident of Chesterfield. The Chesterfield County Police Department responded to Neal's residence and took him into custody without incident. Neal was transported to the Colonial Heights Police Department where he was charged with Aggravated Malicious Wounding, Use of a Firearm in the Commission of a Felony, Shooting from a Motor Vehicle, Reckless Handling of a Firearm, and Possession of Marijuana with Intent to Distribute.

Neal was transported to Riverside Regional Jail where he is being held without bond pending a court hearing on September 9, 2024.
