Colonial Heights Police Make Arrest for Narcotics and Weapons Offenses

On January 19, 2025, at 11:30am Colonial Heights Police located an occupied, stolen vehicle in a parking lot of a business in the 600 Block of the Boulevard. Responding officers quickly took the driver into custody without incident.

Darius Tyvon Williams, 31 years of age and a resident of Dinwiddie County has been charged with Grand Larceny, Possession of a Schedule One/Two Narcotic with Intent to Distribute, Possession of a Concealed Firearm, Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon, Possession of a Firearm While in Possession of a Schedule One/Two Narcotic and Provide False Information to Law Enforcement. In addition, Williams was served with outstanding Failure to Appear warrants from the City of Colonial Heights, the City of Petersburg and Dinwiddie County.

Williams was transported to the Magistrate's Office where he was ordered held without bond at Riverside Regional Jail pending his next court appearance in Colonial Heights General District Court.
