ADOPTION OF:

AN ORDINANCE NO. 08-FIN-13 (First Reading). To amend the General Fund Budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008, to transfer \$165,218 to provide additional funds; such funds coming from Contingencies, debt issuance savings, and interdepartmental transfers.

AN ORDINANCE NO. 08-14 (First Reading). To amend and reordain §250-17 of Chapter 250, Subdivision of Land, of the City Code so as to increase the processing fee for subdivision plats; and amending §§286-12, 286-16, 286-16.7, and 286-147 and Appendix 2 of Chapter 286, Zoning, of the Colonial Heights City Code, so as to increase certain zoning-related fees.

AN ORDINANCE NO. 08-16 (Second Reading). To amend and reordain §218-2 of Chapter 218, Peace and Good Order, of the Colonial Heights City Code, to make the provisions of certain State criminal statutes effective in the City of Colonial Heights by local ordinance, effective July 1, 2008; and to repeal Ordinance No. 07-16.

AN ORDINANCE NO. 08-17 (Second Reading). To amend and reordain §273-2 of Chapter 273, Vehicles and Traffic, of the Colonial Heights City Code, so as to adopt the provisions and requirements of the laws of the Commonwealth contained in Title 46.2, in Article 9 of Chapter 11 of Title 16.1, and in Article 2 of Chapter 7 of Title 18.2 of the Code of Virginia, effective July 1, 2008; and to repeal Ordinance No. 07-17.

AN ORDINANCE NO. 08-18 (First Reading). To amend and reordain § 218-1.1 of Chapter 218, Peace and Good Order, of the Colonial Heights City Code to completely ban opened alcoholic beverages in City parks, playgrounds, and streets.

AN ORDINANCE NO. 08-19 (First Reading). To amend and reordain §273-42 of Chapter 273, Vehicles and Traffic, of the Colonial Heights City Code to exempt one vehicle owned or leased by any deputy sheriff, police officer, officer of the State Police, salaried firefighter, and salaried emergency medical technician from the annual vehicle license fee.

A RESOLUTION NO. 08-10. To amend the “Schedule of Parks and Recreation Fees” to raise certain fees.

A RESOLUTION NO. 08-13. Ending the disaster declared on April 28, 2008, because of the tornadoes and/or windstorms that damaged the City that day.

OTHER ACTIONS

Directed the Planning Commission to reconsider its decision with regard to the waiver of the requirements for curb and gutter, storm drainage and sidewalks associated with the resubdivision of 1905 Boulevard and further directed that if the Commission reapproves the waiver, it specify the rationale for making the four findings required for the waiver.

Consensus to provide four directional lights at Appamatuck Park for security purposes, per a request of Councilman Freeland, at a cost of approximately \$8,200.
