OTHER ACTIONS

The City Attorney was directed to proceed with the development of an ordinance allowing the waiver of local license motor vehicle fee for paid public safety personnel, effective January 1, 2009.

The City Attorney was directed to proceed with advancement of an ordinance changing the procedure by which the City collects payment for delinquent parking citations and changing the procedure by which persons charged with violations may contest their citations, with a public hearing to be held on the ordinance.

The City Administration was directed to proceed with the implementation of the Virginia Department of Transportation Urban Construction Program.

The City Administration was directed to proceed with the proposed fee increases for the Department of Recreation and Parks and the Department of Planning and Community Development, with the City Attorney developing an ordinance for a public hearing.

City Council expressed its support for the installation of a lighted crosswalk on Conduit Road.

City Council directed that William G. Broaddus, Esquire, of the McGuireWoods law firm, be retained to assist the City in any possible litigation concerning the redevelopment of the Colonial Heights Courthouse.
