**Council advanced a draft of Public-Private Educational Facilities and Infrastructure Act (PPEA) guidelines for public hearing at the Regular Meeting in November.**

**Council rescinded a motion from the October Regular Meeting to request a public hearing at the Planning Commission level for the rezoning of the properties at 401 Temple Avenue and 231 Chesterfield Avenue. City Manager permitted to research an appropriate individual to lend the City assistance in the development of specifications for a PPEA on the renovation of the former church building to a courthouse with three courtrooms.**

**Council advanced a draft of an amendment to Section 258-16.2 of the City Code relating to minimum investment to qualify for tax abatement in the Southpark Development District for public hearing at the Regular Meeting in November.**

**Council approved the location of a donation box at the boat ramp in Roslyn Landing and that the money collected by the City be appropriated to the Colonial Heights Appomattox River Trail System (C.H.A.R.T.S.).**

**Council approved the rescheduling of the Regular Meeting in November from November 10<sup>th</sup> to November 18<sup>th</sup>.**
