

**ACTIONS
COLONIAL HEIGHTS CITY COUNCIL
JULY 21, 2009**

Council directed the City Attorney to prepare an ordinance for the creation of zones, one for the Southpark area and the other for the Boulevard, relative to real estate tax abatement incentives for development projects.

Council directed the City Attorney to proceed with the preparation of an ordinance regarding the regulation of itinerant merchants, to include the issuance of a license limiting operation to 30 consecutive days per calendar year.

Council directed the City Attorney to proceed with the redraft of Chapter 98, Animals, of the City Code. Ordinance to be considered on first reading at the Regular Meeting of August 11th.

Council approved the recommendation of the City Manager with regard to the final design and phasing for the Vo-Tech Center Sports Complex.

Council approved the recommendation of the City Manager with regard to an administrative waiver process for driveway entrance construction or reconstruction.

Council directed that the Administration develop guidelines pursuant to the Public-Private Educational Facilities and Infrastructure Act (PPEA) and that the Circuit Court Judges be contacted and a meeting arranged to obtain their insight on the proposal from the Reuse Committee to relocate the courthouse to 231 Chesterfield Avenue.
