ADOPTION OF:

A RESOLUTION NO. 09-11 - Authorizing the City Manager to enter into a lease purchase agreement with Branch Banking & Trust Company to obtain a sewer vactor truck.

A RESOLUTION NO. 09-12 - Designating KBT (Kenney Bank and Trust) as a depository for the City of Colonial Heights for a period beginning March 1, 2009 and ending February 28, 2010, in accordance with billing by Advanced Data Processing for Emergency Medical Services.

OTHER ACTIONS

Directed Real Estate Analyst Mr. Parks Rountrey to develop two addendums to the appraisals for properties located at 401 Temple Avenue (the site of the Colonial Heights Courthouse) and 231 Chesterfield (the site of the former Colonial Heights Baptist Church).

Directed City Manager, in conjunction with the Fire Chief, to investigate penalties of other localities relative to alarm systems and report their findings at the work session on March 17th.

Consensus of Council not to formally support The Excel Institute and Pathways due to potential requests for future monetary obligations.

Directed City Manager and City Clerk to write a letter of response on behalf of City Council to Ms. Carrie Gibbs regarding her letter of February 11th concerning obstructed view of traffic turning onto the Boulevard at a specific location.
