A RESOLUTION NO. 10-16. Requesting permission from the Commonwealth Transportation Board for installation of a right-in/right-out access to and from property located in the Southpark Shopping Center at 1891 Southpark Boulevard from and onto Temple Avenue.

A RESOLUTION NO. 10-17. Authorizing the Acting City Manager to enter into a revised Appendix A of a “Standard Project Administration Agreement” with the Virginia Department of Transportation that was previously authorized, pertaining to signal coordination on the Boulevard from Sherwood Drive to Temple Avenue.
