

**ACTIONS
COLONIAL HEIGHTS CITY COUNCIL
FEBRUARY 16, 2010**

Council adopted the proposed Courthouse Action Plan, with minor changes.

Council advanced the stormwater management utility fee concept with continued discussion to be held at the Work Session on March 16th.

Council denied a request for adoption of an ordinance permitting the operation of golf carts on certain designated City streets.

Council agreed to reactivate and rename the Industrial Development Authority (IDA) to the Economic Development Authority (EDA) with modifications being made to its purpose and rules of procedure. Council also agreed to use business license taxes paid as an economic development incentive on a case by case basis and to send out a Request for Proposals and interview potential real estate brokers for the City's retail parcels on Dimmock Parkway.

The City Attorney was directed to develop an ordinance expanding the membership of the Senior Citizens Advisory Committee from five to seven at-large members.

Council advanced a draft ordinance for public hearing that would deny issuance of a business license if the applicant owed the City certain taxes.

Council advanced a draft ordinance for public hearing relating to restitution for emergency responses in certain situations.

Council advanced a draft ordinance for public hearing relating to earphones on or in both ears on a public street, sidewalk or right of way.
