**ADOPTION OF:**

**AN ORDINANCE NO. 12-3. (First Reading). To grant a special use permit to KHJ, LLC, for property located at 800 West Roslyn Road. The property is presently zoned IN Industrial District, has parcel identification numbers 6805380004A, 68050000012C and 6805000012B, and comprises 11.5 acres. The special use permit would allow for the property to be used for a restaurant not to exceed 2,000 square feet, which would be located in the existing farm museum building; and allow for a freestanding pole sign not exceeding 45 feet in height and 192 square feet in size, to be located within 500 feet of the Interstate 95 highway right-of-way.**

**AN ORDINANCE NO. 12-FIN-5. (Second Reading). To amend the General Fund Budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2012, to appropriate \$10,000 in donated funds to the Library to be used to upgrade equipment and for reading programs.**

**AN ORDINANCE NO. 12-FIN-6. (Second Reading). To amend the Capital Projects Fund Budget to appropriate \$300,000 to Streets and Bridges; \$150,000 for the Dupuy Avenue Modernization Project, and \$150,000 for the Lakeview Avenue Modernization Project; such funds coming from the Commonwealth.**
