ORDINANCE NO. 13-FIN-4

(Second Reading) Adopting the Recreation Activity Fund Budget for the Fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2014, and appropriating the estimated revenues for the year for the operating expenses stated.

ORDINANCE NO. 13-FIN-6

(Second Reading) Adopting the Storm Water Fund Budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2014, and appropriating the estimated revenues for the year for the principal purposes stated.

ORDINANCE NO. 13-FIN-7

(Second Reading) Adopting the General Fund Budget for the Fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2014, and appropriating the estimated revenues for the year for the objects and purposes stated herein.

ORDINANCE NO. 13-FIN-8

(Second Reading) Appropriating and providing funds for financing the City of Colonial Heights Public School Budget for the Fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013 and ending June 30, 2014 and approving such budget.

ORDINANCE NO. 13-FIN-9

(Second Reading) To amend the General Fund Budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2012 and ending June 30, 2013, to appropriate funds in the amount of \$12,500 from the library's donation account for the repair of surveillance system cameras 9(\$3,000), operating supplies reimbursement (\$3,000), three computers (\$2,500), and the Summer Reading program (\$4,000).

ORDINANCE NO. 13-4

(Second Reading) To amend and reordain §32-12, of Chapter 32, Fire Department, of the Colonial Heights City Code, to provide for an increase in service fees for emergency ambulance transport.

ORDINANCE NO. 13-5

(Second Reading) Adopting the Water and Sewer Fund Budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2014, and appropriating the estimated revenues for the year for the operating expenses stated.

ORDINANCE NO. 13-6

(Second Reading) Providing for a levy on all real estate located in the City not exempt from taxation to be fixed at \$1.14 for the tax year commencing January 1, 2013, and ending December 31, 2013; and providing for a levy on all real estate located in the City not exempt from taxation to be fixed at \$1.14 for the tax year commencing January 1, 2014, and ending December 31, 2014, for general municipal purposes.

ORDINANCE NO. 13-7

(Second Reading) Providing for a tax levy on all tangible personal property not either exempt from taxation or otherwise taxed, for the tax year ending December 31, 2013; and for the tax year commencing January 1, 2014, and ending December 31, 2014; for general municipal purposes.

ORDINANCE NO. 13-8

(Second Reading) Providing for a tax levy on motor vehicles owned by members of a volunteer rescue squad or volunteer fire department, and persons appointed to serve as auxiliary police officers for the tax year ending December 31, 2013; and for the tax year commencing January 1, 2014, and ending December 31, 2014, for general municipal purposes.

ORDINANCE NO. 13-9

(Second Reading) Reaffirming Ordinance No. 12-7, which provided for a personal property levy of one dollar (\$1.00) on each motor vehicle which is specifically equipped to provide transportation for physically handicapped individuals for the tax year commencing January 1, 2013, and ending December 31, 2013; and providing for such levy on motor vehicles which are specifically equipped to provide transportation for physically handicapped individuals for the tax year commencing January 1, 2014, and ending December 31, 2014, for general municipal purposes.

ORDINANCE NO. 13-10

(Second Reading) Establishing a tax rate pursuant to Chapter 35.1 of Title 58.1 of the Code of Virginia (“Personal Property Tax Relief”) on all qualifying vehicles under the Chapter.

ORDINANCE NO. 13-11

(Second Reading) Providing for a tax levy on machinery and tools, tangible personal property used in a research and development business, certain energy generating equipment, personal property used in manufacturing, testing or operating satellites, and motor vehicles, trailers and semitrailers with a gross weight of 10,000 pounds or more used to transport property for hire by a motor carrier engaged in interstate commerce, for the tax year ending December 31, 2013; and for the tax year commencing January 1, 2014, and ending December 31, 2014; for general municipal purposes.

ORDINANCE NO. 13-12

(Second Reading) To amend and reordain §238, Sewers and Sewage Disposal, of the Colonial Heights City Code, to increase charges for sewer service.

ORDINANCE NO. 13-13

(Second Reading) To amend and reordain §277-9 of Chapter 277, Water, of the Colonial Heights City Code, to increase charges for water service.

ORDINANCE NO. 13-14

(Second Reading) To adopt a revised General Pay Plan Class and Salary Range that includes the Grade Assignment for Economic Development Director.
