**ORDINANCE NO. 13- 3**

(First Reading) To amend and reordain Section 244-14 of Chapter 244, Solid Waste, of the Colonial Heights City Code, by specifying where garbage cans and containers, and recycling cans and containers, must be moved after being emptied; and providing for penalties for violations.

**ORDINANCE NO. 13-FIN-1**

(Second Reading) To amend the General Fund Budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2012 and ending June 30, 2013, to appropriate funds in the aggregate amount of \$31,752, consisting of \$2,000 from the Walmart Foundation to be used towards the purchase of D.A.R.E. materials by the Police Department; \$1,425 in unexpended funds from the Department of Conservation and **Recreation's** Pocahontas Program to the Office on Youth; and \$28,327 in contingencies to be used by Public Safety for Career Development.

**ORDINANCE NO. 13-FIN-9**

(First Reading) To amend the General Fund Budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2012 and ending June 30, 2013, to appropriate funds in the amount of \$12,500 from the **library's** donation account for the repair of surveillance system cameras (\$3,000), operating supplies reimbursement (\$3,000), three computers (\$2,500), and the Summer Reading Program (\$4,000).
