AN ORDINANCE NO 13-FIN-14 (Passed)

(Second Reading) To amend the General Fund Budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2014, to appropriate \$144,581, which consists of \$112,381 in additional State funding changes, grants, and intergovernmental reimbursement; \$1,000 in donated funds from Wal-Mart for the Kids After-School Program for program supplies; \$6,000 in grant funds from DMV to the police for selective enforcement of alcohol offenses; \$25,200 from Restricted Funds for purchase of a street crime van and vehicle repair.

AN ORDINANCE NO. 13-FIN-15

(First Reading) To amend the General Fund Budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013 and ending June 30, 2014, to reflect a two percent cost of living increase for employees, effective January 1, 2014; to appropriate \$15,122 reserved from the Fund Balance to the city Manager; and to appropriate \$3,037 in grant funds from the Virginia Department of Historical Resources to Community Development.

(First Reading) To amend §273-27 of Chapter 273 of the Colonial Heights City Code, which relates to the parking of any trailer, boat, or camper in residential districts.
