CHARLESTON, SOUTH CAROLINA

4 Days - 3 Nights

The sample itinerary described below is approximately like the itinerary your group will be following during your stay with WHITE STAR TOURS. However, the exact times, days, and destinations may vary for your group.

- Day 1** - A morning departure has you heading to quaint **Charleston, South Carolina**. Upon arrival, you will check into the **Hampton Inn Historic District** and prepare for dinner at a local restaurant.
- Day 2** -Following breakfast, meet your guide for a **Historic Charleston Tour**, one of the most beautiful and historic cities in the South. During your tour you will see White Point Garden, Rainbow Row, Old Exchange Building, Four Corners of Law, Site of Gadsden Wharf, the U.S. Custom House, Ashley Hall, The Battery, the College of Charleston, and several historic churches. At the conclusion of the tour, there will be time for lunch on your own in the **Old City Market** area as well as doing some shopping. In the afternoon, take a **Harbor Cruise and visit Fort Sumter**, which is known as The Battery. Fort Sumter was built following the War of 1812 and is best known as the site upon which the shots initiating the American Civil War were fired at the Battle of Fort Sumter. After the cruise, return to your hotel to prepare for dinner which will be at one of Charleston's fine restaurants.
- Day 3** -Enjoy breakfast, then depart for a visit to the **Magnolia Plantation** where you will have a **tour** of the home and a **Nature Tram Tour** of the Gardens. The Plantation dates back to 1676 and is one of the oldest plantations in the South. This afternoon, head for Madmalaw Island and the **Charleston Tea Plantation**. You'll learn all about how tea is made at America's only tea factory as you walk through the glassed-in, air conditioned gallery that runs down virtually the entire length of the facility. Later, board a trolley for a tour over the many acres and acres of tea bushes. You'll learn more about tea both from the trolley guide as well as founder, Bill Hall, who narrates a portion of the tour. The trolley also makes a stop at the greenhouse where you'll get to see just what it takes to bring new tea bushes into the world. Returning to Charleston, you'll enjoy dinner at another of Charleston's fine restaurants.
- Day 4** - Following breakfast, check out and depart for home with fond memories of **Charleston, SC!**
